athletics track	bieżnia

golf course	pole golfowe
gym	siłownia, sala gimnastyczna

squash/tennis court	kort do squasha/tenisa

When you invite a person to do sports with you, you must use a verb **GO**, **PLAY** or **DO** with different sports.

USE :

GO with individual sports, sports you can do alone

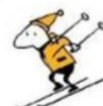
Ex. Do you want **to go** jogging with me?

PLAY with team sports (you need a partner), competitive sports (you play to win!)

Ex. Do you want **to play** soccer with me?

DO with martial arts, like karate

Ex. Do you want **to do** karate with me?



We use either the verb **to play**, **to do** or **to go** to refer to sports.

E.g. *He **plays** football. She **does** gymnastics. We **go** snowboarding every winter.*

PLAY + Sport

We use **to play** for the following sports: football, netball, cricket, baseball, basketball

DO + Sport

We use **to do** for the following sports: gymnastics, martial arts (sztuki walki) eg. judo, karate, kung fu

GO + Sport

We use **to go** for the following sports: swimming, snowboarding and snow-skiing, hang-riding, parachuting, horse riding
