What is Mothering Sunday?

Mothering Sunday is a celebration held to honour mothers .

The day has evolved into an occasion for children to honour and give presents to their hardworking mums.

In the UK, it was originally linked to religion but has since lost a lot of its connections to the church and is mainly a family day.

When is Mother's Day in other countries?

Around the globe, Mother's Day is celebrated on different days from February to December.

- Ireland March 22
- France June 7
- Spain December 8
- Portugal May 3
- Middle East March 21
- Hungary May 3

- Austria -May 10
- Switzerland May 10
- Greece and Cyprus -May 10
- Israel February 25
- Russia March 8
- Ukraine May 10
