	<b>affirmative</b>	<b>negative</b>	<b>question</b>
<b>I</b>	I played	I didn't play	Did I play?
<b>he/she/it</b>	He played	He didn't play	Did he play?
<b>you/we/they</b>	You played	You didn't play	Did you play?
