<p><u>Travel</u></p> <p>Travel means 'travelling in general'. It is normally uncountable.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ I love cinema and travel. <p>The word 'travel' is used to talk about going from one place to another, and can be used as a noun or verb.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ Verb: Susie travels a lot.❖ Noun: Travel nowadays is much cheaper. <p>The plural travels is sometimes used it means a grand exploration or travelling</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ Have you read the book; travels to the Pacific Islands? It's fantastic	<p><u>Journey</u></p> <p>A journey is one piece of travelling. Going from one destination to another, it can refer to a long distance or a short regular one.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ Did you have a good journey?❖ The journey was very tiring, it took 5 hours to get there.	<p><u>Trip</u></p> <p>A trip is a return journey together with an activity/activities. Business or pleasure is the reason for the journey.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ I'm going on a business trip next week.❖ Can we take a trip to the zoo? <p>Note: We do not use trip for expeditions which have a serious purpose, and are hard or take a very long time to complete.</p> 
<p><u>Tour</u></p> <p>A tour is a journey where several places are visited and usually takes place on holiday. Tour can be used as a noun or a verb.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ Noun: We went on a tour of Spain❖ Verb: We toured the Central regions of the United States.
